Policy Number: A008

RULES FOR RESOLUTION SESSION

- 1. The delegates shall vote on the resolution and <u>not</u> on the recommendation of the Resolutions Committee. The recommendation of the Committee is only for guidance.
- 2. If an amendment is proposed, either by the Committee or the floor, the delegates will vote on the amendment first then on the main resolution.
- 3. If more than one amendment is made, the amendments will be voted in the reverse order the amendments are presented.
- 4. Only the operative clause will be read.
- 5. Order of speaking shall be decided by the Chair.
- 6. Delegates are requested to state their name and the municipality they represent.
- 7. A delegate will be allowed two minutes to speak on the resolution and an additional minute will be allowed for a rebuttal.
- 8. Only when every delegate wishing to speak, has been given an opportunity, will the delegate be allowed to speak a second time. The time limit to speak a second time will be limited to one minute.
- 9. A delegate will be limited to speaking no more than twice.
- 10. The chair has the prerogative to close-off discussion on a resolution or if the question is called for.
