Policy Number: A009

I. BEARPIT PARTICIPANTS

Each member of the panel will be allowed a maximum of five minutes for their opening remarks.

II. RULES FOR QUESTION PERIOD

- 1. Only official delegates shall be allowed to address the members of the Bearpit Session.
- 2. Order of speaking shall be decided by the Chair.
- 3. Delegates are requested to state their name and the municipality they represent.
- 4. Delegates are requested to state the person to whom they wish the question to be directed.
- 5. Delegates will be allowed to ask one question plus a supplementary.
- 6. Speakers will be limited to a total of two minutes on the main question plus one minute for the supplementary. This time includes any preamble or background the delegate wishes to provide.
- 8. Only when every delegate wishing to speak, has been given an opportunity, will the delegate be allowed to speak a second time. The time limit to speak a second time will be limited to one minute.
